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Program Focus:

- Twice a week face-to-face meetings with trained ADHD/LD coach
- Regular check-ins during the week
- Student-driven plan of action
- Develop time management and organizational skills
- Build Independence
- Second-year option for those who participated in the program for the first year

- Second Year: \$1,650/semester
